The JVS Supported Employment Program

What is Supported Employment?

The Supported Employment Program helps individuals with disabilities find paid work in community settings.

How does it work?

JVS will help you obtain employment based on your interests, needs and abilities. When you start your job, you will be accompanied by a job coach who will help you learn your tasks until you can work independently.



What other support services can I get?

JVS will also assist you with identifying the support services you may need to keep your job. Examples include:

- Identifying potential transportation providers to get you to and from your job site
- Talking with your employer about special accommodations
- Establishing vocational goals and providing feedback about your progress
- Linking you with natural support systems

What happens after training?

JVS will provide you with intensive training until you learn the job. We will survey you on a regular basis to make sure that you are satisfied with your job. As necessary, you will receive additional training or supportive counseling to help you maintain your employment.
